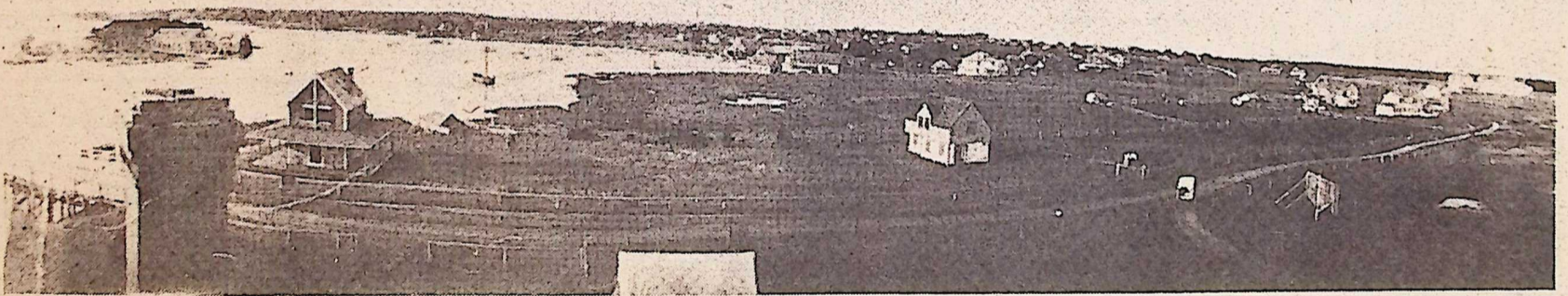
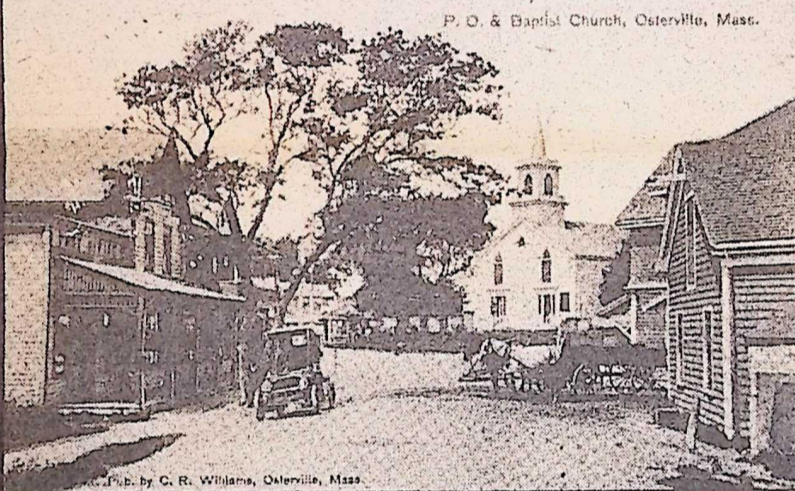


OSTERVILLE

Paul L. Chesbro and Chester A. Crosby III, authors of a new pictorial book- "OSTERVILLE - A WALK THRU THE PAST", are pleased to announce that pre-subscription orders are now being taken. The book contains 500 photos of Olde Osterville from 1860 to 1930, and is being published by the William S. Sullwold firm of Taunton, Mass. The publication is a pictorial history of the village of Osterville and not a detailed history.

The photos contained in the book include old scenes, street scenes, 40 school pictures dating from 1888-1920, a large section on Wianno and Sea View Aves, Crosby Boat Yards and about 50 pictures of men and women who lived in Osterville years ago and who helped make it the village it is today.

Chapter one will contain the "Rich Letter", written in 1877. This is a detailed letter, beautifully written by Augusta (Lovell) Rich, about the village and its people of the day. The letter will be explained so that readers will know where they are today- 1979.

There are 10 chapters in all. Chapter one has been mentioned. Chapters 2 through 9 will be accompanied by detailed

maps to explain exact locations referred to by Mrs. Rich. Each photo is numbered and will correspond to the number on the map and in the letter. Chapter 10 is titled "Odds and Ends" and will contain 50 photos of scenes from around the village which just don't seem to fit into the other chapters.

Many, many hours have been put into this book and a copy should be in every home in Osterville.

Those who pre-subscribe will have their names printed in the book. A cut-off date for pre-subscription orders will be April 1, 1979.

The book is a 9" x 12" hard cover with an attractive jacket (see above), and 160 pages. 1,000 copies will be printed with no second editions. The release date will be late spring or early summer.
